## **2008 Rules & Regulations**

Please take a moment to review and understand our 2008 Golf Rules and Regulations. It is our mission to provide the best customer service to our residents and guests. As a courtesy to all golfers, Tashua expects that proper etiquette, dress code, and pace of play rules will be observed at all times. Players renting carts are reminded to use care and exercise safety precautions to prevent injuries to themselves or other golfers, as well as to prevent damage to the golf course.

### **\*\*DRESS POLICY**

- \*Collared shirts are required (no t-shirts or tank tops allowed), mock turtlenecks are permissible.
- \*Golf slacks or khaki's preferred. (No blue Jeans/Denim will be allowed on golf course) Blue jeans are permitted at the practice facilities.
- \*Bermuda shorts (No running shorts, tennis shorts, bathing trunks or cut-offs allowed).

### **\*\*TEE TIMES**

- \*All players may book a tee time 7 days in advance via the telephone, in the golf shop, or on-line. ([www.tashuaknolls.com](http://www.tashuaknolls.com))

### **\*\*NO SHOW / TEE TIME CANCELLATION POLICY**

- \*All golfers are required to cancel 24 hours prior to their tee time. Tee times cancelled inside of this window may be subject to charge and the group's name noted.
- \*Golfers who fail to cancel their tee will be: a) noted in our system b) will be charged a \$20 no show fee/ number of players booked and c) repeat offenders may be subject to suspension from future bookings.

### **\*\*CHECK IN POLICY**

- \*All golfers must register at least 15 minutes prior to their tee time. Our starters will expect your full group to be waiting on deck 10 minutes prior to your scheduled tee time. The pro shop is not responsible for golfers that arrive late. Golfers registering after this time period may lose their previously scheduled time. If a group member is running late, please pay for them and our staff will graciously escort them out to the group.
- \*Please arrive to the first tee prepared to play. We recommend having your extra tees, balls, and spotter in your pocket prior to arriving at the first tee.

**\*\*SPIKE POLICY:** Tashua golf course is a soft-spike facility. Steel spikes are prohibited.

### **\*\*PACE OF PLAY POLICY**

- \*All players are expected to play READY GOLF.
- \*On a busy day, our expected time of play is 4 hours, 12 minutes. Please average 14 minutes per hole.
- \*It is your group's responsibility to maintain pace of play with the group in front of you.
- \*Our Player Assistants will utilize a Flag system and pace of play clocks. If our PA approaches your group and hangs:
  - GREEN FLAG:** Your group is moving along fine at the proper pace of play.
  - YELLOW FLAG:** Caution, your group is falling behind in time. Please pick up the pace and get back into position. (1<sup>st</sup> official non-verbal warning)
  - RED FLAG:** Your group is at least one hole behind. You will have one hole to improve your position. If you are having a problem, we will ask your group to skip a hole. If the group continues to fall behind, your group may be asked to leave the course.

**\*\*GOLF CAR POLICY:** Golf carts are available to players 18 years of age and older with a valid driver's license.

**\*\*Please exercise courtesy to all other golfers and the Tashua golf staff.**

*Please note: Blatant disregard of our Rules and Regulations may result in the suspension or loss of your resident I.D. card.*
